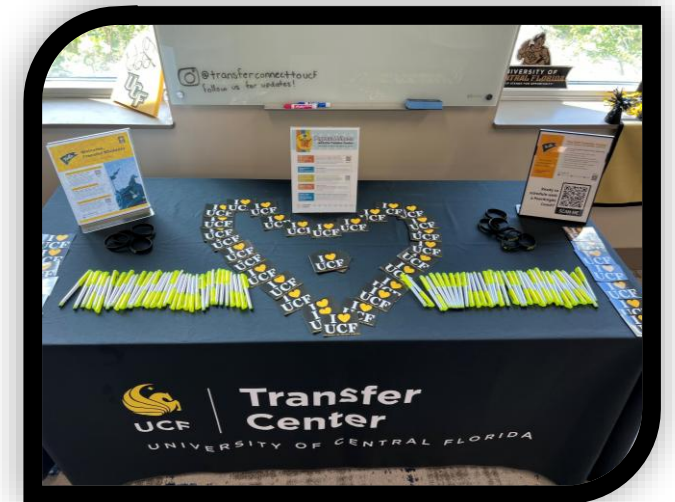

# WHAT IS “TRANSFER SHOCK?”

A temporary GPA dip common during the first semester after transfer.

## *Causes of "Transfer Shock"*

- New Environment
- Adjustment Difficulties
- Academic Rigor/Advanced Courses
- Unaware of Resources
- Imposter Syndrome

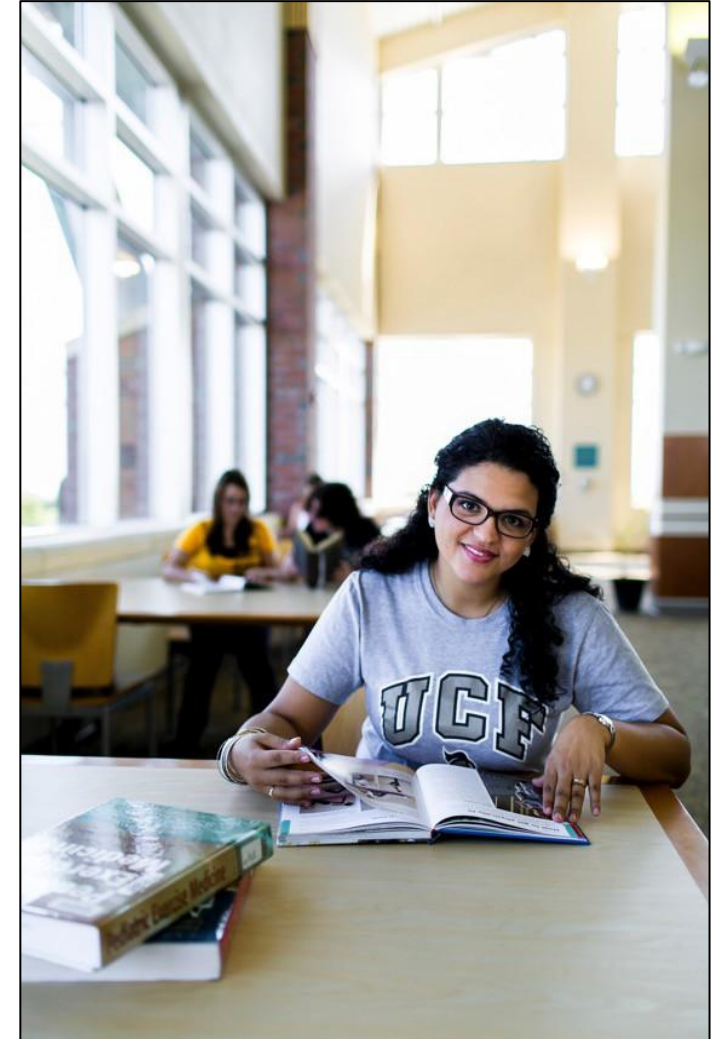
