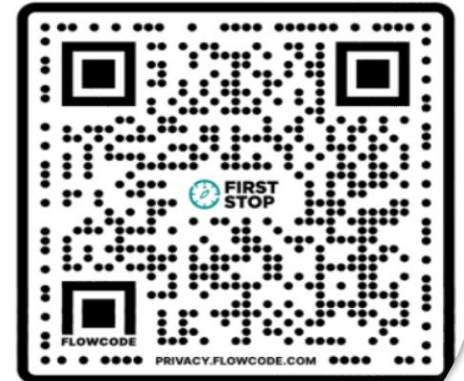

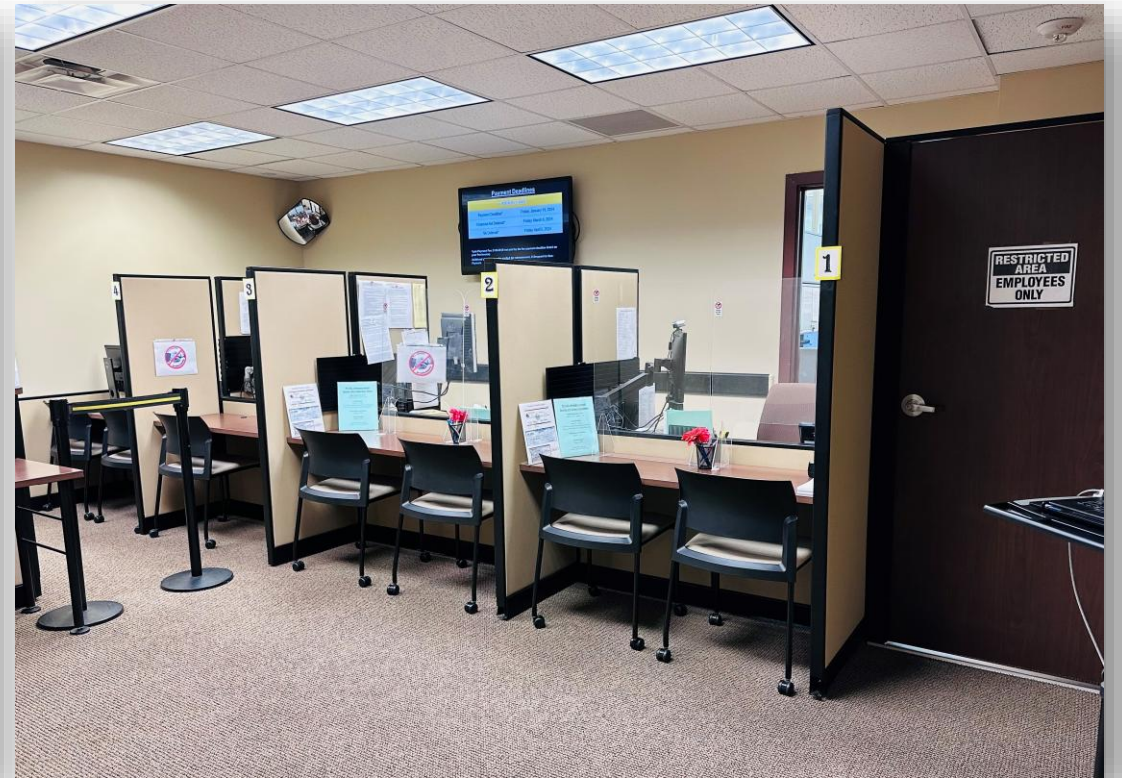

 - Late Registration Fee: \$100.00 (If your first attempt to register is during this week)
- Drop/Swap Deadline: last day to drop classes and not be fee liable

Florida Prepaid Tuition

- You are not required to notify our office that you want to use your Prepaid plan. Our billing system links to Florida Prepaid with your SSN.
- Your Florida Prepaid will reflect on your fee invoice by the first day of classes.
 - *If your Florida Prepaid is not showing prior to the Payment Deadline, please contact Student Account Services for assistance at tpbilling@ucf.edu*
- UCF will automatically bill Florida Prepaid for the number of hours in which the student is enrolled.
 - *Students wanting to cancel or adjust billings for a specific term must update the hours to bill in their myUCF prior to the end of the term's add/drop period. For instructions, please visit <https://studentaccounts.ucf.edu/florida-prepaid/>*
- **Fees not covered by the plan must be paid out of pocket or covered by other sources.**



529 Savings Account

- Please contact your 529 investment firm to use these funds
 - *These are not considered third party billing.*
- 529 checks can be mailed to Student Account Services.
 - *Please ensure your student's name and UCFID are on the payment, as well as what the payment is for.*
- A student may incur late fees and may be placed on financial hold if the payment is received after the payment deadline.



Tuition Deferment

- Financial Aid
- Florida Prepaid
- Third Party Billing
- Waiver

Tuition may be deferred to a later date. To view: Access your myUCF to view your fee invoice and click on “Due Charge,” to view if your tuition is deferred.

- Deferment is not guaranteed
- Student is fully responsible for payment by “Due Charge” date

Payment Plan

- Available in myUCF portal
- Link to opt in is available at the beginning of the second week of classes
- There is a \$15.00 mandatory processing fee
- 50% of total tuition and fees is due upfront
- Students with financial aid, Florida Prepaid, waivers or third-party payments are NOT eligible for the plan.

Any excess funds will normally be refunded to you via direct deposit (if enrolled) or in the form of a check



Refunds

Direct Deposit (highly recommended)

- Student's bank account; any U.S. financial institution
- Student's name must be on the account
- Student must sign up on myUCF (2-part process)
 - *Student Self Service > Student Center > Student Direct Deposit*

Paper Checks

- Mail to current mailing address indicated on student's myUCF

Parent Plus Loan refunds

- Mail to parent's address provided on Plus Loan form

Federal Direct Loans

- Not credit based
- 6-month grace period (a period when a student is no longer enrolled for at least half-time and not required to make payments)
- Fixed interest rates
- Can begin to accept in July on myUCF

Subsidized Loans

- Government pays the interest
- Need-based
- Undergraduate students

Unsubsidized Loans

- Interest accrues immediately
- Independent students may be eligible for greater unsubsidized amounts



Florida Bright Futures

- Determined by the State of Florida Office of Student Financial Assistance (OSFA).
- UCF must be identified as your post-secondary institution on the Initial Student Florida Financial Aid Application (FFAA).
- Bright Futures is awarded on a per credit hour amount.
- Bright Futures funds up to 120 credit hours.

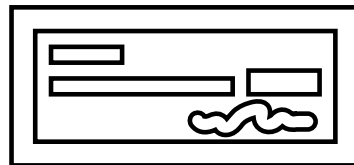

Disbursement Process

- Disbursements begin after the Drop/Swap and Add period and when the student's file is complete.
- Awards are reviewed and adjusted to reflect their actual enrollment.
- Not all awards disburse at the same time in all cases.
- Financial aid refunds begin after the 2nd week of classes.

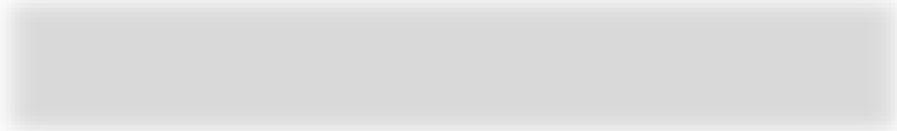
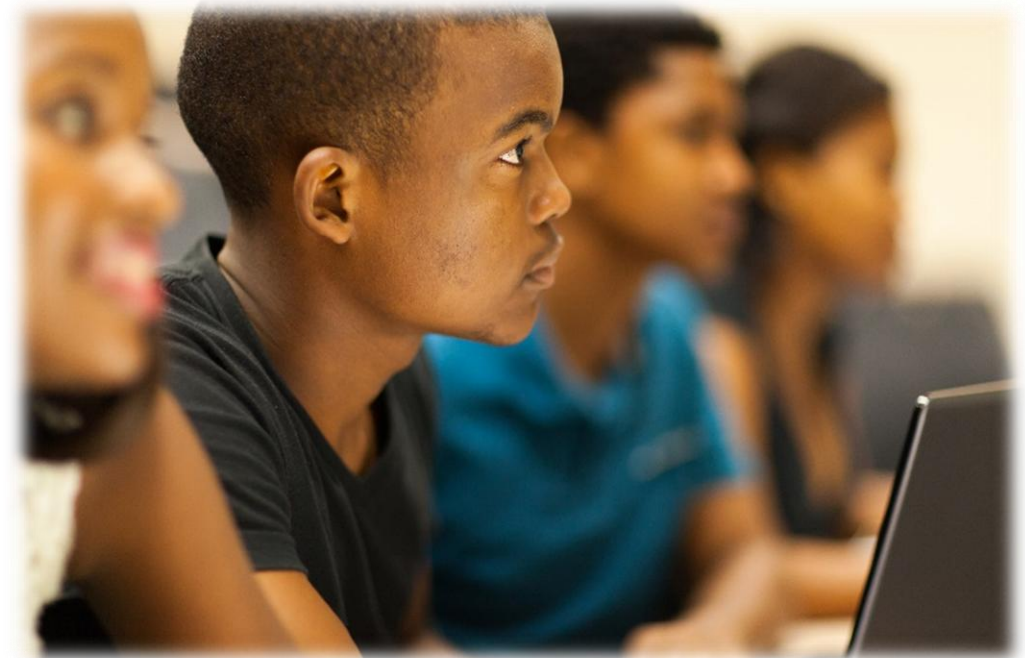

Academic Activity

- Aid will disburse based on the number of credit hours in which an academic activity has been confirmed.
- Students will be in jeopardy of not receiving all their federal aid.
- Complete the academic activity by the end of drop/add week.
- Confirmation of an academic activity occurs every semester.





Funds For Books

- Textbook purchase program
- Short-Term Advance



Special Circumstances

- Change in employment status
- Medical expenses not covered by insurance
- Change in parent's marital status
- Death of the student's parent

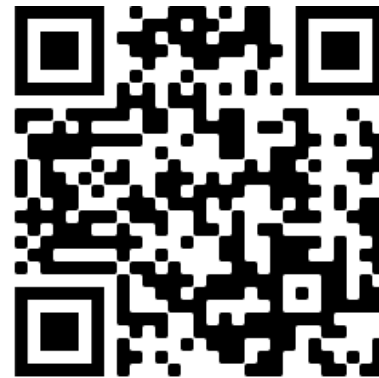
