Record Release Authorization

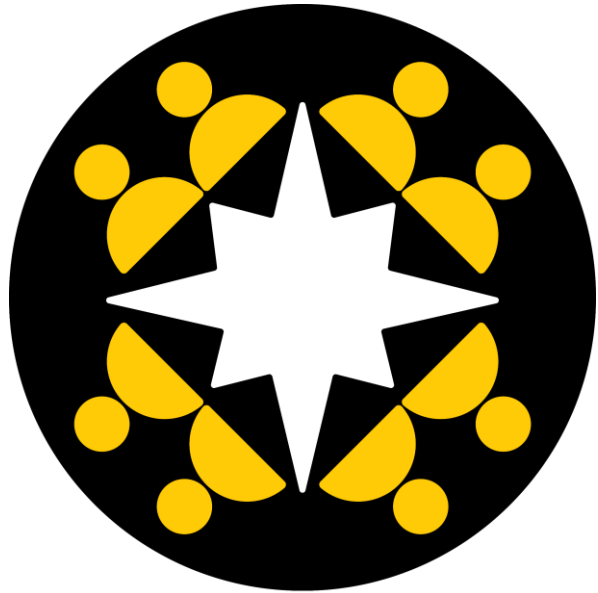
